On arrival you will be greeted by a member of staff at the Nursery door.

Clothing

The Blackwood Primary School uniform is:

When we come in to Nursery we hang our coats on a peg. This is where we keep our spare clothes.

Please make sure your child brings a spare set of clothes in a named plastic bag which we can keep on their pegs in case of accidents!

Please try to dress your child in clothes that are as easy as possible to take on and off. For example –shoes with Velcro fastenings and not laces, joggers with elasticated waists etc. This encourages their independence.

We will be going outside as often as possible so if you can provide your child with wellies to stay in school and make sure they have appropriate waterproof clothing.

Please label your child's clothes clearly, especially shoes and coats. Clothing often gets lost or muddled up and it really helps us to make sure your child goes home with the correct clothing.





Snacks and Drinks

Healthy snack can be brought in each day for your child or alternatively snack money can be paid on a Monday at £1 per week.



Milk is also provided free of charge whilst, so there is no need to bring anything into school apart from your child's own bottle, clearly marked with their name to avoid confusion we just ask that this only be filled with water.

Please let us know if your child has any food allergies/ intolerances that we should know about on the contact form.
