Journey Summary:

In Year 3/4 we will be exploring the question 'What is sustainable tourism?' During this theme pupils learn about tourism and the impact this can have on people and places of their choice through pupil influence at the start. They will develop an understanding of what a carbon footprint is, and promote sustainable travel and local destinations for tourism in groups. At the heart of this project children will learn how to write and create adverts and develop additional skills in the use of persuasive and descriptive language to promote places and their natural/human features.
